COMMERCIAL LUE POLICY

New User -

Usage to be reviewed after three full months usage, LUE count to be set by dividing average monthly usage by 12,000 gal. (400 gpd) and rounding all fractions up.

Annual Review –

Test Period - Calendar Year, January through December

- A) Divide average monthly usage by 12,000 gal., round any fraction up.
If result is higher than existing LUE count, this is new LUE count.
If result is lower than existing LUE count go to B.
- B) Divide average monthly usage by 6,000 gal., round any fraction up.
If result is lower than existing LUE count, this is new LUE count.
If result is higher than existing LUE count, LUE count to remain the same.

Summary: If a commercial user is using more than 12,000 gal/mo/LUE, their LUE count will be increased. If a commercial user is using less than 6,000 gal/mo/LUE, their LUE count will be decreased.

The Board reserves the right to adjust LUE count outside of policy of any commercial user based on a minimum change of 20%.
